- Tilly Toyota arrives, expanding capacity and reach across the outback.
- Smithy and Sue meet. Together they acquire Billabong Boat Cruises and create the iconic Drivers Sunset Cruise, and purchase the river block for future Smithy's restaurant.
- Smithy and Sue marry, cementing a partnership that would define outback tourism for generations.



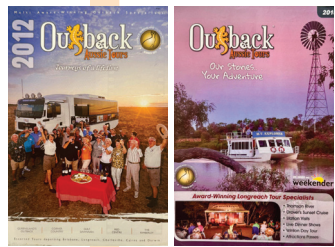

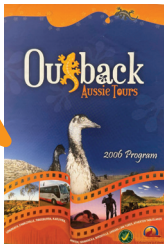

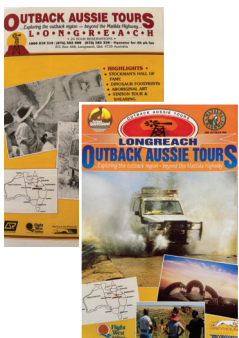

- Polly, a 45-seat coach, joins the fleet, enabling larger groups.
- Day tours and extended multi-day packages operate simultaneously, establishing dual-track touring model.
