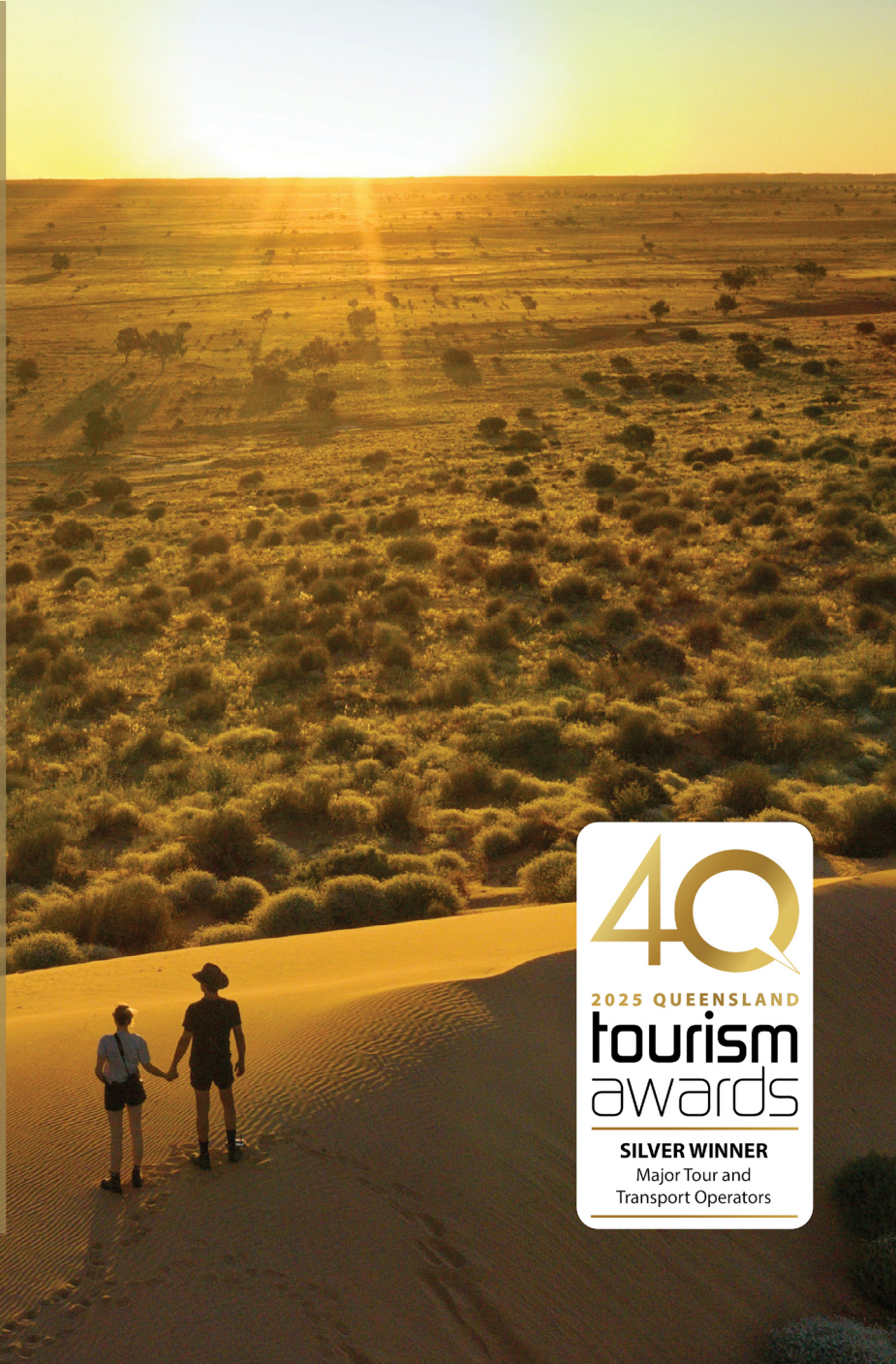

### Day 1: TUESDAY | BRISBANE TO CHARLEVILLE

Board your REX Airlines flight in Brisbane for a birds-eye view of the lush Darling Downs agricultural region before heading west to big sky country. You will be welcomed on arrival in Charleville by your Savannah Guides Operator driver and host. Explore Charleville on an insightful town tour before checking into your accommodation. Early evening, visit the Charleville Cosmos Centre for the Outback Stargazing Tour. See an amazing night sky brought into focus with the help of powerful Meade telescopes and listen to captivating stories from their experienced sky guide. ### Day 2: WEDNESDAY | CHARLEVILLE

This morning, we tour the historic secret United States Army Air Force (USAAF) base with a local guide and discover the reasons behind choosing Charleville as a WWII base. Explore the Royal Flying Doctor Service Museum, then step inside the famous Hotel Corones, built during Charleville's wool industry boom. Join a guided tour with exclusive access to normally restricted areas of the hotel, followed by lunch in the hotel dining room. Visit the Charleville Bilby experience for a tour of the nocturnal house. Discover the remarkable volunteer program underway to preserve this environmental engineering marvel. (B) (L) (D)

### Day 3: THURSDAY | TOOGUNNA PLAINS FARMSTAY

This morning, be inspired by the farmer who turned a long-term dream into reality with a tour of the Charleville Date Farm. Learn how dates grow, how reclaimed water came to be used for this environmentally friendly project, and best of all, enjoy delicious date loaf. Heading west, to Lake Houdraman, which is a beautiful expanse of water set amongst shady gum trees. Discover the Lake, a property with a guided station tour and enjoy a delicious lunch. Following lunch, we take a guided tour of Quilpie, including a visit to St. Finbarr's Church and its stunning Opal Altar. This afternoon we check into our accommodation. Enjoy an exclusive sunset tour to nearby rolling red sandhills where the contrasting outback colours dazzle. After a big day of activities, enjoy a gourmet paddock-to-plate dinner experience. (B) (L) (D)

*2 nights Toogunna Plains Farmstay, Quilpie*

### Day 4: FRIDAY | TOOGUNNA PLAINS FARMSTAY

This morning, enjoy a station tour of Toogunna Plains. Learn the history of this 4th-generation family-owned sheep and cattle property. This afternoon, relax and enjoy the panoramic views of this vast open plain, before we travel to Eromanga, Australia's furthest town from the sea and home to Australia's largest dinosaur. Get up close to a 95-million-year-old

dinosaur bone on the Australian Dinosaur Giants tour at the Eromanga Natural History Museum. Savour the Tastes of the Outback degustation dinner in the museum gallery tonight. (B) (L) (D)

### Day 5: SATURDAY | TIBOOBURRA

This morning, we visit the historic Noccundra Hotel, before crossing the border at Warri Gate into outback New South Wales. View the eastern sections of the Sturt National Park. Traverse gibber plains and spectacular 'jump-up' country to Tibooburra. The striking granite boulders around Tibooburra are said to be remnants of a mass underground granite dome dating back around 410 million years. Explore the National Park's Interpretive Centre and Court House Museum. (B) (L) (D)  
*Overnight Tibooburra Hotel or Family Hotel, Tibooburra*

### Day 6: SUNDAY | INNAMINCKA

Travel through Sturt National Park to Cameron Corner, where the boundary lines of the states of Queensland, South Australia, and New South Wales meet. See the Strzelecki Desert, characterised by extensive red dune fields, home of the Dusky Hopping Mouse. Pass by large cattle stations, then travel through the heart of the oil and gas fields to Innamincka, on the banks of the Cooper Creek. (B) (L) (D)  
*2 nights Innamincka Hotel, Innamincka*

### Day 7: MONDAY | INNAMINCKA

Retrace the last days of Burke and Wills and learn the story of Innamincka, dubbed 'the town with two lives'. Visit Burke's original resting place, marked beneath a large tree along Cooper Creek. Learn the important role played by the Australian Inland Mission in providing essential medical services to remote towns. Tonight, we toast the glorious outback Innamincka sunset as we watch a blanket of stars rise above the famous Outpost on Cooper Creek. (B) (L) (D)

### Day 8: TUESDAY | BIRDSVILLE

This morning, visit the heritage-listed Burke & Wills Dig Tree, an enduring reminder of the pioneering spirit and extreme harshness of the Outback. While there, you'll have the opportunity to stroll the boardwalk and spot the local birdlife. Follow the Strzelecki Desert through flood plains, sand dunes, and gibber country. Travel through large stations, including Arrabury, which is over 700 square km in size. En route to Birdsville, we call into Deon's Lookout, the famous Betoota Hotel, and the Dreamtime Serpent Indigenous artwork. Tonight, yarn with the locals and enjoy a dinner at the famous Birdsville Hotel. (B) (L) (D)

*2 nights Birdsville Hotel, Birdsville*

### Day 9: WEDNESDAY | BIRDSVILLE

This morning, visit the Wirrarri Centre to view work by local Indigenous artists. Next, take a stroll to the Birdsville Billabong with birdlife, fish, and yabbies abound. Stand on the well-known Birdsville Racetrack and explore the Inland Hospital and Royal Hotel ruins, poignant reminders of a pre-federation metropolis. Tonight, we'll toast the glorious outback sunset from Big Red Sand Dune, a 40-metre-high sand dune on the edge of the Simpson Desert. (B) (L) (D)

**Day 10: THURSDAY | BOULIA**

Leaving Birdsville this morning, we'll visit the Carcory Ruins, a heritage-listed homestead built in 1877 and abandoned after years of drought. Explore the remote town of Bedourie, located on a sand dune, overlooking the Eyre Creek floodplain. See the Royal Hotel, built in the 1880s with adobe bricks and still very much in its original condition. Witness spectacular 360-degree views from the Vaughn Johnson Lookout. In Boulia, we'll visit the Min Min Encounter, a tribute to the famed mysterious Min Min Light phenomenon. Explore the Stonehouse Museum, one of the first homes built in Western Queensland, and see the impressive Marine Reptile Fossil exhibit. (B L D)

**Overnight Australian Hotel & Desert Sands Motel, Boulia**

**Day 11: FRIDAY | WINTON**

Follow the spectacular scenic drive between Boulia and Winton. Call in at Cawnpore Lookout to view the stark flat-topped beauty of the surrounding Lillyvale Hills. Visit the historic Middleton Hotel, built during the Cobb & Co. era. Uncover the story behind the song that lives in the heart of all Australians at Winton's Waltzing Matilda Centre. This afternoon, we visit the Australian Age of Dinosaurs, perched high on a spectacular mesa. Join a guided interpretive tour of the Laboratory, Collection Room, and Dinosaur Canyon. Take in the moment at our very special sunset barbecue overlooking the plains where dinosaurs once roamed! (B L D)

**Overnight Boulder Opal Motor Inn, Winton**

**Day 12: SATURDAY | LONGREACH**

Departing Winton, we follow the Matilda Way east to Longreach, where we spend a relaxed morning downtown. After lunch, we explore the fascinating themed galleries at the Australian Stockman's Hall of Fame and discover inspiring stories of our pioneering heroes. This evening, we visit the Qantas Founders Museum for the entertaining and informative Luminescent Longreach Sound & Light Show, which brings the 100-year-old story of Qantas to life, followed by an exclusive dinner surrounded by aviation history. Wander through the interactive displays to discover the real Qantas story. (B L D)

**2 nights Longreach Motor Inn, Longreach**

**Day 13: SUNDAY | LONGREACH**

This morning, we board the heritage 2000-class Rail Motors en route to Ilfracombe. Explore the unique attractions in "the Hub of the West," including the Wellshot Centre and Machinery Mile, and enjoy lunch at the famous Wellshot Hotel. Late afternoon, join the Drover's Sunset Cruise. Unwind with on-board nibbles as you gaze out to a magnificent outback sunset. ## Day 1: WEDNESDAY | CAIRNS

Your adventure begins with a Welcome Dinner at our hotel. Please check-in after 2.00pm. You will be met by your Savannah Guides Operator driver and host at the Welcome Dinner. Meet fellow travellers and hear all about the adventures ahead with a comprehensive tour briefing by the team. (D)

## Day 2: THURSDAY | COOKTOWN

We travel north along one of Australia's most scenic coastal drives to Wangetti Beach to Hartley's Crocodile Adventures for an escorted private tour. See some of the largest crocodiles being pole fed, meet gorgeous koalas and feed the wallabies and kangaroos. Continuing north we travel to Mossman, nestled in the World Heritage-listed Daintree River, where we take the ferry for a short cable crossing of the Famous Daintree River. Visit the Daintree Discovery Centre, an award-winning interpretive facility. Join a guided tour along the rainforest boardwalks. Follow the Bloomfield Track on a spectacular scenic journey hugging the Daintree Coast. Visit Wujal Wujal, a small coastal Aboriginal community on the banks of the Bloomfield River. (B) (L) (D)

**Day 3: FRIDAY | COOKTOWN**

Discover Cooktown’s colourful history today. We’ll visit the Cooktown Cemetery, where you’ll learn the intriguing story of a fair-skinned woman known as the ‘Normanby Woman’ who was seen living with Indigenous people back in the 1800s. Visit the Cooktown Museum in the magnificent 19th Century Sisters of Mercy Convent. Gain an insight into the grounding of the Endeavour and the most significant land-based stay of Captain Cook’s East Coast expedition. Wander the beautiful heritage-listed Cooktown Botanic Gardens and see the Vera Scarth-Johnson collection of original regional botanical illustrations. Enjoy some free time before a late afternoon tour of Grassy Hill with 360-degree views of Cooktown, the Endeavour River and the Great Barrier Reef. (B) (L) (D)

**Day 4: SATURDAY | MUSGRAVE**

Travel to Lakeland and Laura via the mysterious Black Mountains, a special story place for the Kuku Yalanji people. World-class Aboriginal rock art and wonderful locally grown coffee are two big drawcards for these small towns. Best known are the Quinkan Rock Art Galleries, considered to be some of the most significant Aboriginal art sites in the world. We’ll join a guided tour

of the Split Rock Galleries. Travel along the Peninsula Developmental Road to the Hann River Roadhouse for a short break before continuing on to Musgrave Roadhouse.

**Day 5: SUNDAY | WEIPA**

We continue along the Peninsula Developmental Road to the old mining community of Coen. The town was originally created around a repeater station for the Overland Telegraph Line to the Tip of Cape York Peninsula. We’ll arrive in time for lunch at the Archer River Roadhouse, located on the banks of the crystal-clear Archer River. Famous for the massive Archer Burger, best served with an icy cold drink under its shaded patio. Last stop for the day is Weipa, the Barramundi capital of Queensland. Originally an Aboriginal mission, Weipa grew to become a township after the discovery of bauxite. Late afternoon, relax at your accommodation with sweeping views of Albatross Bay. (B) (L) (D)

*2 nights Albatross Bay Resort, Weipa*

**Day 6: MONDAY | WEIPA**

Learn about Weipa’s mining operations on a morning tour of the world’s largest bauxite

mine, operated by Rio Tinto. Get up close and personal with the 190-tonne Belly Dumper Haul trucks while touring the working mine site and follow the rail and conveyor belt system as the bauxite makes its way to the loading dock. Join an Eco Cruise on the Gulf of Carpentaria for a chance to spot local birdlife and crocodiles. Relax with drinks and nibbles as you learn about the incredible ecosystems and local culture. Witness a stunning sunset in one of the few places in Queensland where the sun sets over the ocean in the west.

**Day 7: TUESDAY | BAMAGA**

Follow the Old Telegraph Track to Moreton Telegraph Station on the banks of the Wenlock River. Part of the historic Overland Telegraph Line, Moreton Telegraph Station was completed in 1887 and ceased operations in 1987 with the introduction of microwave telecommunications. Spot giant termite mounds as the country changes to the open plains of Heathlands Resources Reserve. Cool off in the lush Fruit Bat Falls with its crystal-clear water (croc free), a perfect swimming

spot and one of the highlights on the tour. Cross the Jardine River by cable ferry to Bamaga, the closest settlement to the Tip of Australia. This evening, enjoy a relaxed dinner overlooking tropical gardens. (B) (L) (D)

*2 nights Cape York Peninsula Lodge, Bamaga*

**Day 8: WEDNESDAY | BAMAGA**

Experience the highlights of Cape York Peninsula, one of Australia's last great wilderness areas. We begin with a drive to Pajinka. The 45-60 minute walk over rocky headland to 'The Tip' of Cape York requires a good level of fitness. Take that 'bucket-list' photo as you stand at the tip of Australia, then savour a picnic lunch on Somerset Beach with breathtaking views of Albany Island. Visit the iconic Croc Tent, then enjoy some free time back at your accommodation before dinner.

**Day 9: THURSDAY | TORRES STRAIT ISLANDS**

Cruise the beautiful turquoise waters of the Endeavour Strait to Thursday Island; just one of 274 islands which lie between the northern tip of Queensland and Papua New Guinea. Discover Thursday Island's hidden past, including Green Hill Fort, on a guided history tour and a visit to Gab Titui Cultural Centre. Join Island Stars for an entertaining, educational and spiritual showcase of traditional dance, storytelling, songs and

music. This unique show brings together two of the world's oldest living cultures, Aboriginal and Torres Strait cultures. After the show enjoy a traditional island lunch before taking some free time to explore Thursday Island.

**Day 10: FRIDAY | CAIRNS**

Transfer to Horn Island this morning. Join local guides on a tour of the World War II sites. See gun emplacements, an underground command post and an aircraft wreck with an epic tale. Walk in the steps of traditional owners, the Kaurareg People, and learn their stories. Following the tour, you will have time to wander the Torres Strait Heritage Museum. Transfer to Horn Island Airport for your QantasLink flight to Cairns. Tonight, we'll celebrate the end of our adventure with a farewell dinner at the Coral Hedge Brasserie Restaurant & Bar.
