Key Responsibilities

- Safely and confidently operate the MV Longreach Explorer to provide guests with an informative and memorable experience.
- Welcome guests and check manifests.
- Conduct coach transfers and pick ups for river cruises and experiences when required
- Passion for introducing guests to the environment, people and places
- Provide accurate and informative interpretation with high value client engagement whilst using multimedia, reference books and props
- Develop and implement schedules for the maintenance of the Boat and work with local and external mechanic and vehicle maintenance companies.
- Inspect, record and resolve any boat maintenance issues and report to the Operations
 Manager and Business Manager in a timely manner.
- Ensure that the boat is mechanically maintained, fuelled and presented to a high standard to meet OAT and guest presentation expectations.
- Maintain the boat maintenance log and ensure it is up to date and accurate.
- Liaise with the Operations Manager to ensure the highest level of safety is maintained across all aspects of the OAT operation and all requirements of the SMS are met.
- Responsible for compliance with the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011.
- Communicate with the Skipper team members regularly about any updates, maintenance issues or safety breaches.
